

Directions to the New Haven Colony Historical Society:

Via I-91, north or south, take Exit 3, Trumbull Street. At the end of the ramp, proceed straight on Trumbull for two blocks to the next traffic light. Turn right onto Whitney Avenue. The museum is 100 yards up Whitney on the left.

Via I-95, exit at I-91 (Exit 48), then follow the directions above.

*Limited parking is available behind the museum building. There is public parking on Grove and Audubon streets. Yale University parking lots are open to the public after 5 pm weekdays and all day weekends.
