

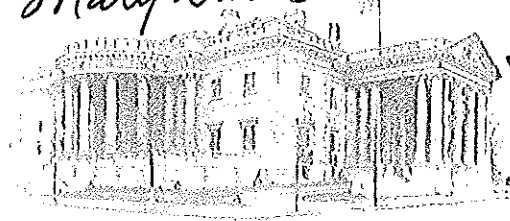

Joseph Hayne Rainey

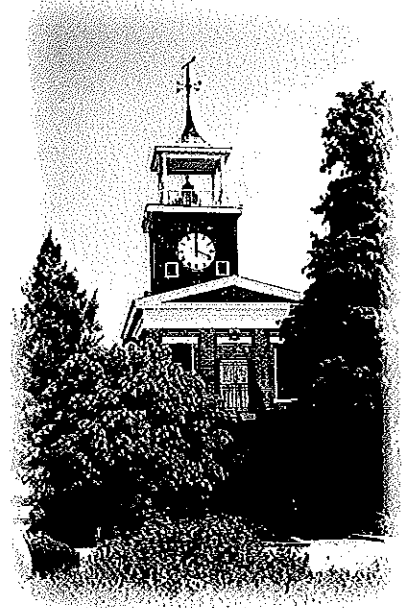
Born in Georgetown, SC June 21, 1832.
