- Mbr of The First Congregational Church

- 1876 - (July 4<sup>th</sup>) nation's centennial year  
Rainey spoke at the Centennial Celebrations  
on the Town Green

- died Aug. 2, 1887 - buried in Georgetown, S.C.

He supported the rights of the Chinese minority  
in California. and of ~~the~~ Native Amns.

He presented civil rights petitions guaranteeing  
Blks their full constitutional rights as well as  
access to public accomodations.
